**TRANSFER CREDITS (if applicable)**

Transfer courses must be from accredited institutions of higher education that offer equivalent level degrees, must be numbered as graduate level according to the course numbering system at the originating institution, compatible with the student's program, and must be equivalent to an "A", "A-", "B+", "B" or "B-" grade. Transfer credit cannot be used to meet any residency requirement and is not used in the calculation of the graduate grade point average. A student who wishes to transfer credit from another university must obtain and complete a Transfer of Credit form at <http://www.unco.edu/graduate-school/pdf/Transfer-of-credit.pdf> and must obtain an official transcript(s) showing the course(s) to be transferred. Doctoral students must complete a minimum of 40 semester hours through UNC of the 64 minimum required for a doctorate degree (if student has a master's degree). All program requirements including transfer work must be completed within the time limits of the degree program.
