CHAPTER TITLE CENTERED IN FULL CAPS

First-Level Heading: Centered Upper and Lower-Case, Bold Font

Second-Level Heading: Centered Upper and Lower-case, Use Plain Font

Third-Level Side Heading in Italics or Bold Font, Upper and Lower-Case

Fourth-level side heading, sentence style capitalization use plain font

Fifth-level, italics or bold font, paragraph indent ending in a period. The paragraph continues on the same line as the heading. ~~Heading~~ is not adjusted if its longer than any length.
