Liberal Arts Curriculum [State of Colorado Guaranteed Pathway (GTP) Curriculum] – Minimum of 31 Credits

Note: Transfer students with an Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, or a Bachelor's degree (regardless of date of completion) from an accredited institution will have their Liberal Arts Curriculum requirements waived.

Written Communication – 6 Credits

Introductory Writing Course and Intermediate Writing Course

OR

Intermediate Writing Course and Advanced Writing Course

Mathematics – 3 Credits

Arts & Humanities, History, Social & Behavioral Sciences, U.S. Multicultural, and International Studies – 15 credits

Select 2 courses from Arts & Humanities, 1 course from History, 1 course from Social & Behavioral Sciences, and 1 additional course from any of these categories.
