 - i. If a student does not pass after a retakte,eir program will be terminated.
 - b. If a retake is NOT permitted, the student's programill be terminated
- c. Notification of individual exam results and overall written comprehensive results
 - i. Following evaluation, exam writers will notify the **MIS** Academic Advis**of** their decision for their exam (i.e. passfail) and may also directly notify the student, at their discretion.
 - ii. TheMS-NT Academic Advisorill compile the individual exam results to determine the final decision. The MST Academic Advisor and the Chair of the SBS Graduate Committee will sign *theport of Written Comprehensive Exams: Master's Degree Non-Thesis*" to file with the GraduateSchooland SBS
